

# Want to get to Herrnhut using public transportation?

Here are our tips for the fastest and cheapest ways to travel from an international airport to our doorstep and arrive in one piece!

## Dresden

Dresden has a beautiful, quiet airport and offers a very easy connection to Herrnhut.

- The bus stops are directly out the front door. Take Bus #80 to **Dresden-Klotzsche** train station. Buy your ticket from the driver. (Bus #77 also goes in the right direction, but you will have to change at least one time.)
- Alternatively, access to the S-Bahn (streetcar/tram) is found on the lower level of the Dresden airport. Buy a ticket at the automat directly by the S-Bahn. Enter Löbau as your destination. Take the S-Bahn #2 (in the direction of Pirna) 5 minutes to the **Dresden-Klotzsche** stop.
- *(You can check out bus and train schedules or buy your ticket ahead of time at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de). The English version of this site may be selected in the upper right-hand corner. Enter "Dresden Airport" as your origin and "Loebau (Sachs)" as your destination.)*
- From **Dresden-Klotzsche** you will take a regional train (in the direction of Görlitz) to the **Löbau** stop. This will take about 1 hour. If you do not already have a ticket, buy one at the automat before you get on the train.
- *If the connection from Dresden-Klotzsche to Löbau is not favorable, it is also possible to take the regional train that goes in the direction of Zittau and get off at the **Oberoderwitz** stop. From here, you will need to be picked up. Check with us ahead of time about the possibility of a staff member picking you up from the train station. Please give a donation of about 5 Euros for gas.*

## From Löbau to Herrnhut

- From **Löbau** take the bus #27 (in the direction of Zittau) about 15 minutes to the **Herrnhut-Zinzendorfplatz** stop. You may buy a ticket from the driver for about 3€. Mention that your destination is Herrnhut. - From the Zinzendorf Platz, cross the street and walk straight ahead, to the left of the large Moravian church. Turn left onto the first street, the August-Bebel-Straße. The Jesus-Haus is located two blocks down on the left.
- *If you are arriving in Löbau late in the evening or on the weekend, there may not be a timely bus connection to Herrnhut. Check with us ahead of time about the possibility of a staff member picking you up from the train station. Please give a donation of about 5 Euros for gas.*

# Prague

Traveling from Prague to Herrnhut is very cheap but takes at least 3 hours and involves several connections. Be sure you are prepared for this! You will need to have cash in Czech Koruna (CZK) to pay for some of your fares throughout this journey. The approximate exchange rate is 25 CZK to 1 Euro. There are two Czech cities near Herrnhut which can be reached from the airport or from the centre of Prague.

## From Prague to Liberec/Zittau (option 1)

- Liberec is located approximately 30 km south of Herrnhut with an easy connection across the German border to the town of Zittau.
- In the airport arrival hall, buy a 90-minute public transport ticket (32 CZK each), plus an extra half-ticket for each large piece of luggage. These are valid for 1.5 hours on all bus, tram and metro lines within Prague.
- From the airport, take Bus #100 to Zlicin.
- Take the Metro B (yellow) to **Cerny Most**. The total journey from the airport to Cerny Most takes about 1 hour.
- Take the Student Agency bus (platform 3 or 7 at Cerny Most) to **Liberec (AN)**. The buses are usually full at least an hour ahead of time, so it is best to book online in advance. You can do this with a credit card. Tickets cost 60 CZK for students and 90 CZK for adults. Booking: <http://bustickets.studentagency.eu/Booking/from/CM/to/LB/passengers/1/>
- The ride to Liberec takes about 1 hour. Exit the bus at the last (2nd) stop in Liberec, at the main bus station.
- Walk up the hill and across the street to the train station. From here you will take the train to Zittau. Check at the ticket counter to see if you need to buy your ticket there or on the train. It should cost 1,70 € or the equivalent in CZK.
- In Zittau, take the Bus #27 about 30 minutes to the **Herrnhut-Zinzendorfplatz** stop (direction of **Löbau**). You may buy a ticket from the driver for about 3€. Mention that your destination is Herrnhut. - If there is not a bus connection available, please contact us ahead of time about the possibility of a staff member coming to pick you up in Zittau. (Please give a donation of about 6 Euros for gas.)

## From Prague to Varnsdorf (option 2)

- The closest Czech town to Herrnhut is **Varnsdorf**, directly on the Czech/German border.
- In the airport arrival hall, buy a 90-minute public transport ticket (32 CZK each), plus an extra half-ticket for each large piece of luggage. These are valid for 1.5 hours on all bus, tram and metro lines within Prague.
- From the airport, take Bus #100 to Zlicin.
- Take the Metro B (yellow, direction of Cerny Most) to **Florenc**.
- Take the Metro C (red, direction of Ladvi) to **Nadrazi Holesovice**.
- Go outside to the bus station to find the bus to Varnsdorf (platform 2, 3 or 7). Tickets cost about 100 CZK, plus about 10 CZK for each piece of luggage. Bus schedule: <http://jizdnirady.idnes.cz/autobusy/spojeni/>
- The bus ride from Prague to Varnsdorf is about 2 hours long.
- Varnsdorf is approximately 25 minutes by car from Herrnhut. Taxis are available. You may also contact us ahead of time about the possibility of a staff member coming to pick you up in Varnsdorf. (Please give a donation of about 8 Euros for gas.)

## Berlin

Berlin has two main airports: **Tegel** and **Schönefeld**. Berlin-Schönefeld is a center for discount flights from other European cities. Berlin-Tegel is the larger airport and has many direct international flights, including from the United States. It will take a total of at least 4 hours to get from Berlin to Herrnhut, not counting extra time needed if your connections do not work out favourably.

- The Berlin Linien Express Bus travels from both Berlin airports directly to the two train stations in Dresden.
- **Tickets must be booked ahead of time.** Bus schedules and booking: <https://www.berlinlinienbus.de>. This website is also available in English.
- Select either **Tegel** or **Schönefeld** as your departure (as applicable) and choose **Dresden-Schlesischer Platz** as your destination. The normal ticket price is 15€ (one way). There are also occasionally special offers for lower fares.
- The Express Bus departs from the main bus platforms at each airport and takes 2-2.75 hours to Dresden. The Schlesischer Platz stop is the first stop in Dresden and is at the Neustadt train station.
- At the Neustadt train station buy a train ticket to Löbau. It will cost approximately 15€. The journey from Dresden to Löbau takes approximately one hour. You may also buy tickets ahead of time at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de) (see above in the “Dresden” section.)
- From Löbau, see the description above. (*From Löbau to Herrnhut*)

## Leipzig-Altenburg

Ryanair has a very economical connection from London-Stanstead to Leipzig-Altenburg. Once arriving in Altenburg, however, it can be rather time-consuming to actually get to Herrnhut. The total journey is 4-5 hours.

- From the airport, take the #250 bus 15 minutes to the first stop, Altenburg. The bus waits for the flight from Stanstead to arrive before it leaves the airport. A single ticket costs 3.50€.
- From Altenburg you will need a train ticket to Löbau. You can buy a “Thüringen-Ticket-Single” for 21 Euros which can be used for 1 day of unlimited travel on regional trains throughout the provinces of Thüringen and Sachsen. (If you are traveling as more than one person, buy the normal Thüringen-Ticket for 29 Euros, which can be shared with up to 5 people.) You will change trains at least in Leipzig and then Dresden before arriving in Löbau, with a total travel time (with connections) of at least 4 hours. Be sure that you only take trains with the RE, RB or OE description or your ticket will not be valid. It is best to ask at the ticket counter in Altenburg or Leipzig for help with your timetable. You may also buy tickets and look at timetables ahead of time at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de) (see above in the “Dresden” section.)
- From Löbau, see the description above. (*From Löbau to Herrnhut*)
